

Pronombres- Pronouns

The learning of subject pronouns is the first step to learning verbs. In Spanish there are more specific pronouns than in English. Also, there are different pronouns depending on what Spanish speaking area you are in.

SINGULAR PEOPLE CATEGORY

YO-I

TÚ- You informal singular (only one person)

ÉL- He

ELLA- She

USTED (UD.)- You formal singular Used in Latin America

PLURAL PEOPLE CATEGORY

NOSOTROS/NOSOTRAS- We (any combination of another person and YO (I))

VOSOTROS/VOSOTRAS- You All (tú's plural form) only used in Spain

ELLOS- They (Él's plural form) for a group of boys, or a mixed group

ELLAS- They (Ella's plural form) for a group of only girls

USTEDES (UDS.)- You All (Ud.'s plural form) used in Latin America.
